In 1986, California voters approved the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act, better known by its original name of Proposition 65. Proposition 65 was intended by its authors to protect California citizens and the State's drinking water sources from chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm, and to inform citizens about exposures to such chemicals.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 800 chemicals since it was first published in 1987. The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be by-products of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

To comply with Proposition 65, businesses are required to display a warning for listed chemicals unless exposure is low enough to pose "no significant risk" of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm. A Proposition 65 warning does not necessarily mean a product is in violation of any product-safety standards or requirements.

Rockwell American determined - and hereby provides notice to its customers - that the products identified in the attached table may result in an exposure to one or more listed chemicals (the "affected products"). As such, these products must be accompanied by a Proposition 65 warning if they are sold to California consumers. These warnings must be visible to customers prior to product purchase.

Online sales of the affected products to California consumers also require a Proposition 65 warning prior to purchase. The warning must be closely associated with each affected product on the product's webpage and must be either 1) on the product's display page, 2) given via a hyperlink using the word "**WARNING**" placed on the product's display page, or 3) displayed, with a tie to the product for which the warning is being given, to the consumer before the purchase is completed (such as having the warning appear when the customer enters a California zip code during checkout process).

Specific warning language for each of the affected products is listed below. These warnings are safe harbor "clear and reasonable" warnings set forth by Article 6 of the regulations implementing Proposition 65 and may be placed on the products themselves.

NOTE: All axle assemblies produced by Rockwell American or any of its divisions must be labeled for possible lead exposure. This includes all complete axle or beam assemblies regardless of part number or other form of identification.

Additionally, the following components as well as kits containing the following components must be labeled for possible lead exposure: all complete brake assemblies, bearings and seals, hubs, drums, hub/drums, rotors, hub/rotors, tie plates, shackle bolts and shackle assemblies, bronze bushings, spindle washers, springs, fenders, surge actuators and trailer couplers, brake pad assemblies, trailer hangers, electrical components, wiring, camshafts and slack adjusters.

Additionally, the following components as well as kits containing the following components labeled for possible DEHP exposure: all electronic-hydraulic actuators, equalizers, grease or oil caps and electrical components and wiring.

Finally, all brake shoes and brake shoe kits must be labeled for possible ethylbenzene exposure.
